- 1. Treasury report was read and accepted.
- 2. The 2014 membership as of Dec 4th, 2014 is 84 members. Club members are urged to pay their dues as soon as possible.
- A motion was passed to repair/replace the Club PA speaker for an estimated cost of less than \$100.00.
- 4. The Christmas Party and Club meeting will be held on Thursday, December 18th at 7:00 PM at the Central Baptist Church located at 601 N. Central Avenue, Eureka MO 63025. The meeting will include a raffle and secret Santa gift exchange. Feel free to bring a dish for others to share.
- 5. A motion was passed to accept the revised 2015 Budget submitted by Ron Lawson for \$13,755.00.

Proposed Constitutional Amendments

1) Purposed Amendment

Article 3, Section 3 currently reads:

All applications to this Association shall be presented at the next scheduled meeting of the Board of Directors. The Board shall vote to either accept or decline each applicant by a simple majority of the Directors present.

Purposed change: Insert "by secret ballot"

If amended Article 3, Section 3 will read:

All applications to this Association shall be presented at the next scheduled meeting of the Board of Directors. The Board shall vote **by secret ballot**, to either accept or decline each applicant by a simple majority of the Directors present.

2) Purposed Amendment

Article 5, Section 1 currently reads:

The PRESIDENT shall preside at all meetings of the Board of Directors and the Membership, sign and issue checks, coordinate all committee activities, negotiate official business and enforce the Constitution and By-Laws of this Association to the best of his or her ability

Purposed change: Insert "ensure that the role of safety officer is filled" If amended Article 5, Section 1 will read:

The PRESIDENT shall preside at all meetings of the Board of Directors and the Membership, sign and issue checks, coordinate all committee activities, **ensure that the role of safety officer is filled,** negotiate official business and enforce the Constitution and By-Laws of this Association to the best of his or her ability.

3) Purposed Amendment

Article 5, Section 3 currently reads:

The SECRETARY shall record the minutes, keep records and active data files of all Members, sign and issue checks, perform official club business and correspond in an orderly manner. The minutes of the Board of Directors meetings shall be read or printed in the club's newsletter and approved by the Membership at the next scheduled meeting.

Purposed change: Insert "and be the registered agent for the club" If amended Article 5, Section 3 will read:

The SECRETARY shall record the minutes, keep records and active data files of all Members, sign and issue checks, perform official club business and correspond in an orderly manner <u>and be the registered agent for the club</u>. The minutes of the Board of Directors meetings shall be read or printed in the club's newsletter and approved by the Membership at the next scheduled meeting.

4) Purposed Amendment

Article 6, Section 3 currently reads:

A Nominating Committee shall consist of the Secretary and one Member at large and shall present a slate of candidates, at least three more persons than positions to be filled, at the first regular meeting in November of each year. Additional nominations may be made from the floor. All Nominees must accept their nomination either verbally or in writing. All Members shall be notified of the complete slate at least five days prior to the election.

Purposed change: Insert "Only Directors who have served for one year or www.slrcfa.com

open members with a $\frac{3}{4}$ majority vote of approval by the Board of Directors may be nominated for Officer positions."

If amended Article 6, Section 3 will read:

A Nominating Committee shall consist of the Secretary and one Member at large and shall present a slate of candidates, at least three more persons than positions to be filled, at the first regular meeting in November of each year. Additional nominations may be made from the floor. Only Directors who have served for one year or open members with a ¾ majority vote of approval by the Board of Directors may be nominated for Officer positions. All Nominees must accept their nomination either verbally or in writing. All Members shall be notified of the complete slate at least five days prior to the election.

5) Purposed Amendment

Article 8, Section 4 currently reads:

A quorum shall consist of the attendance of seven or more Members of the Board of Directors.

Purposed change: replace "seven" with "eight"

If amended Article 8, Section 4 will read:

A quorum shall consist of the attendance of <u>eight</u> or more Members of the Board of Directors.

6) Purposed Amendment

Purposed change: insert Article 12 Section 6

If amended Article 12, Section 6 will read:

Officers and Directors are subject to disciplinary action including removal if three or more board meetings are missed within a calendar year. Written notice will be given pending action. If removed, one may not hold office for the following year.

7) Purposed Amendment

Article 16 currently reads:

The Registered Agent for the Saint Louis Radio Control Flying Association Incorporated shall be appointed by the President and shall remain so at the President's discretion.

Purposed change: insert "the Secretary or"

If amended Article 16 will read:

The Registered Agent for the Saint Louis Radio Control Flying Association Incorporated shall be <u>the Secretary or</u> appointed by the President and shall remain so at the President's discretion.
