SLRCFA'S 3RD ANNUAL WARBIRDS OVER ST. LOUIS



SLRCFA is hosting its 3rd annual Warbirds Over St. Louis Flying event October 3rd and 4th, 9:30am-5pm each day.

This event is \$5 per car for spectators.

Pilots pay a \$15 weekend landing fee and this includes 1 meal ticket to be used on Saturday. Pilot's prizes will be awarded at 5pm on Saturday. Pilots must be current AMA members and must present waivers (if applicable) to fly. ALL warbirds or any military aircraft may fly at this event. This includes Jets (turbine, gas/glow, or EDF), giant scale, standoff scale, fun scale, Helicopters, and parkflyers. Aircraft may be powered by Gasoline, Glow fuel, Turbine or Electric propulsion systems. If it looks like a genuine

warbird....it flys!!! All pilots are encouraged to attend the daily pilots meeting at 9:15am. Any pilot that cannot attend the pilot meeting needs to be briefed by the Event CD (Jonathon Hendrickson) before flying.
